

Subject: Gruppo Cordenons SpA and REACH conformity

Dear Customer,

Paper is an “article” (“...an object which during production is given a specific shape, surface or design determining its use function to a greater degree than its chemical composition does”) for the European Rule 1907/2006 (18 dec 2006) about the recording, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemical substances (REACH).

The duties foreseen by Rule for articles manufacturers are reported in the article n.7; so for our papers and relative raw materials:

- Substances having a deliberated release or a release in normal use conditions or reasonably predictable are not contained.
- Substances having a deliberated release or a release in normal use conditions or reasonably predictable were recorded for this use by our suppliers within the terms of the Rule.
- Are not contained substances which satisfy the standard of article 57 and which are identified according to the article 59 §1:
 - Quantities greater of 1 tons/Year
 - Concentrations more than 0,1% w/w
- Substances that need recording on the basis of the Rule and agency decisions are not contained or they will be notify by us or by our suppliers within the terms of the Rule.
- Substances which need recording on the basis of the Rule and Agency decisions are not contained.
- Substances which need recording on the basis of the Rule and Agency decisions were recorded by our suppliers within the terms of the Rule.

In case of revisions of the Rule will be our care to satisfy new duties, however subordinately to the adjustments of our suppliers.

Note – substances which satisfy the standard of article 57 and which are identified according to the article 59 §1:

- a)- carcinogenic substances, category 1 or 2 by 67/548/CEE;
- b)- mutagenic substances, category 1 or 2 by 67/548/CEE;
- c)- toxic for reproduction substances, category 1 or 2 by 67/548/CEE;
- d)- persistent, liable to bio-accumulate and toxic substances by attachment XIII of the Rule;
- e)- high persistent and high liable to bio-accumulate substances by attachment XIII of the Rule;
- f)- substances which involve the endocrine system or other substances persistent or high persistent, liable to bio-accumulate or high bio-accumulate, toxic, or with high probability (scientifically tried) to involve human health or environment and not included in the above cases are identified case by case following methods of the article 59 of Rule.

The present document is written as an informative and on the basis of our current knowledges.
